

## PREVENTIVE MEASURES AGAINST THE RISK OF COVID-19

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

According to government measures, restrictions in places of worship are not related to the place itself, **but to the activities that take place there**. It is the nature of the activity that dictates the health measures to be observed. For example, churches hosting concerts must follow the same guidelines as those for theaters.

## **CONCERTS IN CHURCHES**

- As of October 8, 2021, promoters of shows with assigned seats are no longer required to impose a limit on the number of spectators and to provide independent areas. The venue can be filled to capacity.
- Masks will be mandatory indoors except when drinking and eating
- For concerts held in a place of worship, people have to present their vaccination passport.
- It is the responsibility of the promoter of the show, not the parish volunteers, to ensure that health standards are met and that vaccination passports are checked at the door.
