INCREASE OF THE CAPACITY OF PLACES OF WORSHIP IN RED ZONES

As of Friday, March 26, the places of worship will be able to accommodate a maximum of 25 people, just in time for the Holy Week ceremonies. The diocesan leadership team wishes to highlight the importance of **opening all places of worship to the public** for this sacred time in the Christian life.

However, the following guidelines must be observed:

- The wearing of a response mask (procedure mask) is mandatory. Make sure you have enough to offer for the congregation as well as for volunteer.
- The measure requiring the mandatory keeping of an attendance register is still in effect.
- A distance of 2 meters must be maintained at all times between persons who do not reside at the same address.
- A singer is permitted for liturgical celebrations. Choirs are always prohibited.

It is strongly recommended to continue videoing and broadcasting the celebrations on social networks for those who will not be able to join the liturgical gatherings.
