WORSHIP CAPACITY OF PLACES OF WORSHIP: REOPENING PLAN

Following the Quebec government's announcements of May 18, 2021, certain relaxation will be granted for the holding of liturgical celebrations in places of worship.

Thus, and subject to any change in the health situation, the number of people authorized to attend celebrations will gradually increase according to the following schedule:
