CATECHETICAL ACTIVITIES AND OTHER PASTORAL MEETINGS

Meetings are allowed to be held with a maximum of 250 participants, provided that all remain seated and that there is a distance of one seat between people. The number of people should be adjusted according to the capacity of the room to allow for distancing. Individuals should wear a mask or face covering and respect physical distancing. The mask can be removed once people are seated. **Vaccination Passport is not required.**

PARISH HALL RENTAL

Parishes are permitted to rent space to individuals or third-party organizations. The sanitary rules to be followed vary depending on the activity that will take place:

- **For a community group:** Support group meetings (e.g., Alcoholics Anonymous) are permitted to be held with a maximum of 250 participants, provided that all remain seated and that a distance of one seat separates individuals. Individuals must wear a mask or face covering and maintain physical distance. The mask may be removed once individuals are seated. Indoor and outdoor recreational and sports activities must follow the guidelines for this type of activity.
- **For a wedding or funeral reception:** Capacity is limited to 25 people. Physical distance must be respected, and face coverings must be worn.
